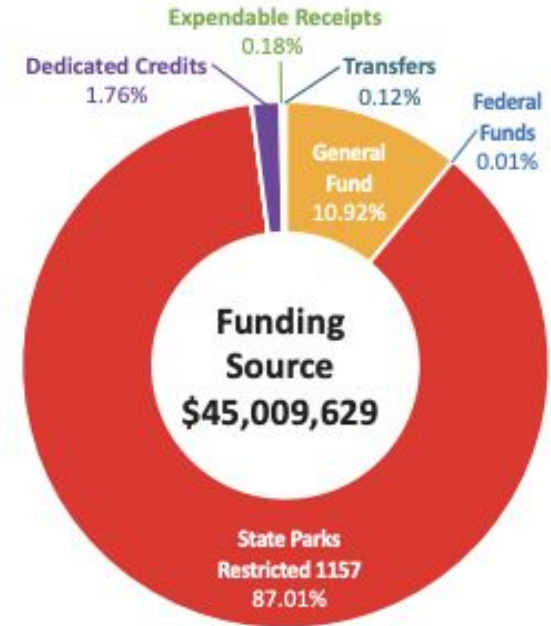
Fee Schedule & Pricing Strategy

How Utah State Parks “Keeps the Lights On”

The majority of Utah State Parks’ Funding comes from the division’s Restricted Account.

These are the funds gathered from the millions of visitors making memories at state parks through day-use access, permits, rentals, overnight stays, and more!

Because so much of our funding relies on our visitors, it is vital that Utah State Parks practices sound businesses and pricing strategies.



Our report provided to the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Office features over 500 individual fees broken down by each individual state park.

These individual fees fit into the 24 categories within the fee schedule that is legislatively approved each year.

This fee schedule helps improve strategic oversight while giving state parks the flexibility to adjust prices appropriately depending on their unique offerings.

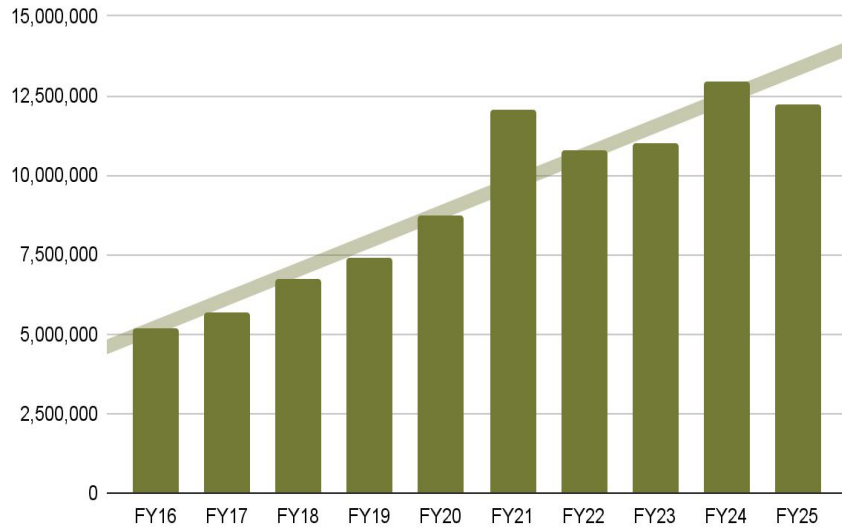

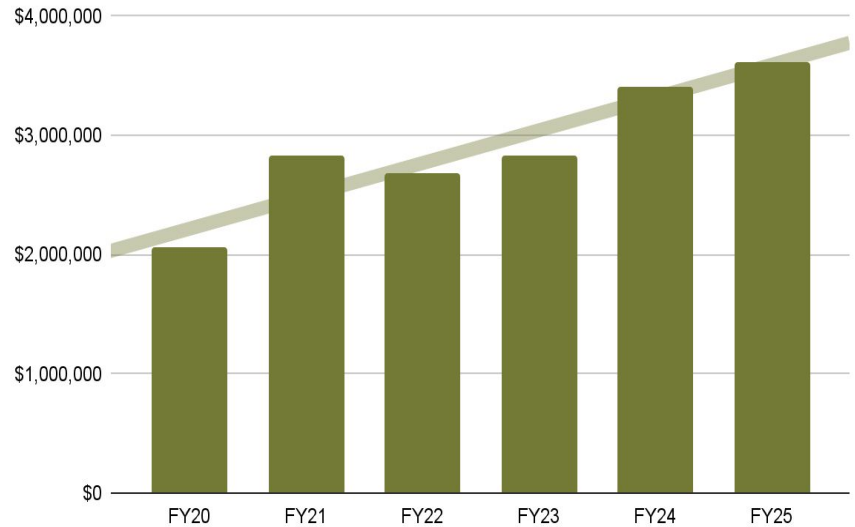
FY26 Utah State Parks Fee Schedule
