The Special Investigative Committee of the Utah House of Representatives (the “Special Committee”), by and through its undersigned attorneys, brings this motion under Utah Code § 36-14-5(2)(a)(i) for an order, in substantially the form of the attached proposed order, compelling the Office of the Utah Attorney General (the “Office”) to comply fully with a document subpoena issued by the Special Committee, and imposing conditions to protect certain electronic data that may be forensically recovered pursuant to the subpoena from unnecessary disclosure.


Utah Code § 36-14-5(2)(a)(i) provides that “[w]hen the subject of a legislative subpoena . . . fails to comply with the legislative subpoena . . . the issuer may . . . file a motion for an order to compel obedience to the subpoena with the district court.” As set forth in full in the accompanying memorandum of law in support of the motion, the Special Committee has issued a

subpoena to the Office. The Office desires to comply with the subpoena and to cooperate with the investigation that the Special Committee was convened to conduct, but the Office has raised an issue under federal law that, in the Office's view, prevents the Office from fully complying. The Special Committee believes that the proposed order will resolve the Office's legal concern and permit the Special Committee to continue with its investigation. The Special Committee therefore respectfully asks that the Court grant this motion and issue the proposed order.

Utah Code § 36-14-5(2)(b)(i) provides that "[u]pon receipt of a motion under this subsection, the court shall expedite the hearing and decision on the motion." The Special Committee therefore further respectfully requests that the Court rule on the instant request for relief on an expedited basis.


