

AMENDED BILL

Costs for the Department of Corrections to update the list of felons under their jurisdiction (jail as a condition of probation and prison incarceration) would be less than \$2,000 per year and can be absorbed within existing budgets. To process the lists for the elections rolls would cost the Lt. Governor's office a part-time employee at approximately \$4,000 per year. Costs to the counties for additional work at the county recorder's level is unknown at this time, but will be impacted by the number of incarcerated individuals from the jurisdiction, whether the county has an automated voter registration/roll system, and the frequency of local elections.

Lack of litigation in other jurisdictions with felon restricted voting (of a variety of types) suggests that there are limited, if any, costs related to challenges to implementation of the provisions of this bill.
