

Assuming fifty additional prosecutions would be conducted each year, the cost to the courts would be approximately \$2,800. Cost for local prosecution cannot be estimated at this time. Penalties for the Class C offense most probably would include fines and probation. Cost of the prosecution and probation would be offset to some degree by increased fine revenue to the state and the prosecuting entities.
