This bill repeals licensing many child care providers. Last year, this licensing function was transferred to the Department of Health, along with funding to accommodate the licensing. If licensing became unnecessary, the Department's budget could be reduced by \$760,000, of which \$152,000 is General Fund and \$608,000 is from federal funds received by the Department of Workforce Services and transferred to the Department of Health. Licensing revenue loss to the General Fund is estimated at \$53,000.
