This bill authorizes an increase of \$0.02 per month for each telephone access line. This could generate up to \$323,000 per year additional revenue for 911 systems throughout the State.

The bill also levies a surcharge of \$0.08 per month per line to pay for costs associated with the Poison Control Center at the University of Utah. This is estimated to generate \$1,291,000 per year. Current funding for the Poison Control Center is \$801,000 in the Higher Education Budget. The funding sources are \$271,000 from the General Fund and \$530,000 from Federal Funds.

The surcharges will increase telephone rates on State, local government, school districts, private business and individual citizens. Additional costs to the State are estimated at \$15,000 General Fund statewide and \$4,200 other funds. Local government will also be impacted by approximately \$20,000 additional expense statewide from Local Revenue.
