

It is estimated that the one-time cost for test development, pilot testing and production materials could be absorbed within existing budgets and resources among the participating entities. Ongoing costs for testing and tracking could be funded by charging a fee to applicants thereby resulting in no fiscal impact to the State.

Individual and Business Impact

Approximately 3,200 applicants per year would be required to take the test and pay a fee ranging from \$25 to \$35 depending on the results of the first year of testing and tracking the program.
