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This bill will divert current fee revenue in the amount of \$160,000 from the General Fund to non-lapsing dedicated credits. The \$40,000 currently appropriated from the General Fund for administration would not be appropriated. The bill allows the diversion of some of the \$160,000 funding from the grants program for administration.

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**Individual and Business Impact**

Applicants for emergency medical services certificates will be required to pay for a criminal background check, at an additional cost of \$25. Organizations receiving grants funds (either per-capita based or competitive) and high school emergency medical training programs could experience a decrease in available funding, since the bill allows an increase in administrative costs prior to the allocation to the above-mentioned organizations.

This bill also directs the Department to review all licenses to identify geographic overlays. Some providers might see their authorized service areas revised.
