

If one-third of the current abstracts filed with the courts go to the counties the State would lose \$149,900 in General Fund revenue. The counties would concurrently see an increase in revenue to cover costs.

Some State agencies may see increased costs in filing liens in those counties that cannot accommodate electronic filing.
