This bill appropriates \$15.4 million in FY 2001 from the Tobacco Settlement Account to the Department of Health (\$9.6 million), the Department of Human Services ((\$4.91 million), Courts (\$650,000), the Department of Corrections (\$160,000) and the Board of Pardons (\$80,000).

Of the \$9.6 million appropriation to the Department of Health, \$5.5 will replace the current Hospital Provider Assessment utilized to fund the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).
