This bill expands the number of licensees increasing both revenue and workload. The bill requires an appropriation of \$59,400 from the General Fund to the Attorney General's Office. An appropriation of \$64,000 from the Commerce Service Fund and \$62,400 from Dedicated Credits to the Department of Commerce is needed to implement the provisions of this bill.
