

**AMENDED NOTE**

**State Impact**

The provisions of this bill will have no fiscal impact the first year, but will require a General Fund appropriation of \$23,200 to the Department of Corrections starting in FY 2003. An incremental increase of \$23,200 is estimated as additional offenders are sent to prison in subsequent years. The additional expenses of the other agencies involved ( i.e. Department of Commerce, Courts) can be absorbed within existing budgets.
