

An appropriation of \$161,200 for FY 2002 to the Department of Commerce is needed to implement the provisions of this bill. Funding for this is covered primarily from increased revenue and shifting of funds from the repeal of the Boxing Commission. A portion of this appropriation (\$28,300) is to cover estimated expenses to be incurred by the Attorney General's Office.

Additional revenue is estimated to be generated for the General Fund Restricted - Commerce Service Fund and as Dedicated Credit Revenue. This could offset most of the increased costs. The required appropriation net increase from the Commerce Service Fund is estimated to be approximately \$25,500, which includes some internal reallocation of funds. Appropriations from the Commerce Service Fund affect the amount available for transfer to the General Fund.
