

State Impact

House Bill 76 itself has no fiscal impact. However, should new districts be created under the process established by H.B. 76, both local governments and the State will be impacted.

State Impact: Under U.C.A. 53A-17a-108, the State must provide between 16 and 53 Weighted Pupil Units (WPU) (\$33,900 - \$112,100) for administration in each new school district, depending upon size. Under U.C.A 53A-17a-113, the State must provide 20 - 25 WPU (\$43,200 - \$52,900) for Applied Technology Education in each new district.

Local Impact: New districts might generate additional administrative costs.

Individual and Business Impact

House Bill 76 itself has no fiscal impact. However, should new districts be created under the process established by H.B. 76, local property tax rates in newly created districts may change.
