

State Impact

Under provisions of this bill, a person under the age of 14 will no longer be required to purchase a fishing license to fish with the same regulations as those 14 or over. In calendar year 2000, 1,825 licenses were sold to persons under 14, bringing in revenues of \$31,900. This revenue would be lost.
