

State Impact

All implementation costs of this bill will be handled within existing budgets. The bill would require an expenditure of federal TANF funds in FY 2003 for the Advisory committee. These funds would convert client service funds into administration funds which may cause a maintenance of effort problem if the program is sufficiently close to its limit. Implementing recommendations as required in the "shall implement" provisions of the substitute bill may cost as much as \$8,632,700 in TANF funding in FY 2004, depending on the recommendations. These increases in spending would come from existing revenues, requiring a reallocation of client service funding.
