## **State Impact**

It is estimated that the Department of Public Safety will require General Funds of \$97,000 in FY 2003 and \$85,000 annually thereafter. The Department of Corrections will require ongoing General Funds of \$88,000 beginning FY 2003. It is estimated that annual fixed collections from offenders able to pay will be \$104,000 beginning FY 2003. It is possible that in future years additional space, equipment, and FTEs will be required to gather and manage the growing collection of DNA specimens.
