

**State Impact**

It is estimated that the participating agencies (Department of Public Safety, Youth and Adult Corrections, Juvenile Courts, and County Sheriffs) will incur costs of \$369,500 in FY 2003 (General Funds: \$267,500 and Restricted Funds: \$102,000) and \$260,800 (Ongoing General Funds: \$158,800 and Ongoing Restricted Funds: \$102,000) in FY 2004.
