

State Impact

It is estimated that General Fund revenues will decrease \$334,500 and collections for FBI checks will decrease \$184,000 in FY 2003 and FY 2004. This is based on an estimate of first time applicants and renewal applicants. It is estimated that the Bureau of Criminal Identification will continue to incur annual costs of \$444,000 in FY 2003 and FY 2004 to conduct the required background checks. It is possible with the termination of fees that the number of applicants will increase in future years.

Concealed carry permit applicants will no longer pay the \$59 initial fee, the \$10 renewal fee; the \$10 replacement fee; or the late renewal permit fee of \$7.50. It is possible with the termination of fees that the number of applicants will increase in future years.
