It is estimated that \$80,000 in supplemental one-time General Funds will be required for system reprogramming costs in FY 2002. (The Department of Public Safety (DPS) will require \$20,000 and the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will require \$60,000.) It is estimated that \$65,000 in ongoing funds will be required by DPS and DMV beginning FY 2003 to defray program administrative/operations expenses. (Ongoing General Funds of \$20,000 and ongoing Special Revenue Funds of \$45,000 derived from donations to the "Out and About Homebound Transportation Assistance Fund" created by the bill will pay for these costs.)
