

State Impact

Costs to implement provisions of this bill is estimated at \$343,300 for FY 2003 due to one time estimated costs of researching cases in the current data base for determining which are to included in the revised base. This amount includes \$278,100 in General Funds. There is a possibility of additional court hearings for cases to be adjudicated to be able to include additional cases in the database. This could impact the Courts, the Attorney General's Office and the Department of Human Services. However, these potential costs are not quantifiable at this time.
