State Impact

The provisions of this bill may provide some small cost savings to Human Service agencies by allowing a few disabled students to remain in the public education system past their 22nd birthday.

State funding for students with disabilities is allocated on an annual basis through the Minimum School Program, based on prior year enrollment and projected growth. This legislation could reduce potential cost savings experienced by school districts, as students with disabilities stay in the system longer. The provisions of this bill may be handled within current allocations.
