## **State Impact**

The fiscal impact of this legislation sums to zero. The bill changes the title and expands the nature of an existing account into which funds are deposited. The funds for this account are received from judgments, settlements, or compromises resulting from actions taken by the Attorney General. The bill could shift where this revenue is currently deposited which may have been to the General Fund or "Other" restricted accounts. The legislation caps the account at \$2,000,000. At the end of each fiscal year, excess funds are transferred to the General Fund.

The Division of Finance monitors all accounts and funds of the State. As the number of funds increase, additional workload is required. The Division of Finance should be able to handle the additional workload with existing resources.
