

SIXTH SPECIAL SESSION**State Impact**

This bill increases the original capital facilities bond by \$36 million. The original bond calculations were included in the budget as adopted during the 2002 General Session, therefore only the increase needs to be accounted for in this fiscal note.

Bond bills are generally issued for a period of six years in which the State pays interest over five years and pays the principal in the sixth year. If the entire amount were issued on July 1, the State would pay approximately \$1.4 in FY 2004 and \$1.4 million in FY 2005.
