

State Impact

The net fiscal impact of this bill is zero. The bill will require approximately 10,000 more individuals to have their DNA tested. Up to \$750,000 could be collected from these individuals for the General Fund Restricted - DNA Specimen Account. These funds will be used primarily by the Department of Corrections and the Department of Public Safety to collect the specimens, process the DNA sample and catalog the results. (There has not been 100 percent collection of the fee due to the impecunious state of some of the individuals required to have their DNA sampled.)
