

**State Impact**

Passage of this bill could decrease the General Fund by \$934,000 in FY 2004 and by \$1,121,000 in FY 2005. Local sales tax revenues would decrease by \$344,000 in FY 2004 and by \$413,000 in FY 2005. The Attorney General would require an appropriation of \$29,000 to implement the provisions of this bill.
