

AMENDED NOTE

State Impact

Currently, each marriage license includes an additional \$20 fee that is collected by the counties for Workforce Services Displaced Homemakers Program. Under the provisions of this bill, a couple could have this fee waived if they elect to undergo marriage education. Since the provisions of the bill do not mandate participation in the program, a quantifiable estimate of fiscal impact is difficult. In FY 2003, Workforce Services received \$531,611. For every 10% of couples taking advantage of the program, Workforce services will lose \$53, 161 in Dedicated Credits revenue. Based on experience in other states, the Analyst estimates 10% revenue reduction.
