Repeal of Exemption from Nonresident Tuition*01-Feb-05**2:28 PM*

State Impact

Repeal of the exemption for nonresident tuition waivers for immigrant non-resident alien students could generate approximately \$200,000 in dedicated credits based on 48 students currently taking advantage of these exemptions. This calculation allows for some students to drop out because of the inability to pay the non-resident tuition rates.
