Nonresident Tuition Waiver for Job Corps Students*25-Jan-05**11:11 AM*

State Impact

This bill increases the number of non-resident tuition waivers by 50 for Job Corp Students at an estimated loss of \$300,000 in dedicated credits (tuition revenue). If this loss is not funded with State resources, the institutions would have to absorb the loss in existing budgets.
