

State Impact

It is estimated that annual ongoing revenues to the state will increase by \$399,800 beginning FY 2007. The proceeds will be deposited in the DNA Specimen Restricted Account according to statute. Beginning FY 2007, the Administrative Office of the Courts will require \$32,800 in ongoing funds and the Department of Public Safety will require \$263,000 in ongoing funds from the DNA Specimen Restricted Account.
