**State Impact**

This bill appropriates \$267,500 ongoing General Fund to the Department of Health. This will be matched with \$622,500 Federal Funds.

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**Individual and Business Impact**

Up to 1,000 individuals could receive increased premium subsidies when they purchase their employer-sponsored health insurance. This could provide a significant savings on health costs to these individuals.

Hospitals and health care providers who care for Covered at Work enrollees may realize additional revenue.

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
