State Impact

New revenue generated by the \$0.25 per tire fee increase provided by the bill is estimated to be \$500,000 in FY 2008 and \$250,000 in the first six months of FY 2009 when the fee increase sunsets. These new funds could be used to relocate waste tire recycling facilities. No additional funds are required to administer provisions of this bill.
