State Impact

Enactment of this bill would require a one-time appropriation of \$12,000 to the Department of Public Safety for programming costs. Increasing the suspension periods for certain offenses decreases revenue to the Public Safety Restricted Account by \$217,000 in FY 2010 and \$333,500 in FY 2011; the action also decreases revenue to the Department of Health by \$45,200 in FY 2010 and \$72,000 in FY 2011 and the Drivers License Division by \$114,800 in FY 2010 and \$176,500 in FY 2011. The amount of the loss decreases to \$3,400 in FY 2012, after which there is no further revenue loss.
