State Impact

Enactment of this bill alters the student eligibility requirements for districts to receive state To and From School Pupil Transportation funding, saving the state approximately \$4,300,000 in ongoing Uniform School Funds. Further, enactment of this bill delays the implementation of the Utah Basic Skills Competency Test for students in the tenth grade for two school years, saving the state an estimated \$500,000 one-time in both FY 2011 and FY 2012.
