State Impact

Enactment of this bill will require appropriations of \$452,400 in General Fund and \$41,900 in federal funds. The bill will generate \$15,100 from court filing fees. The appropriation will go to two agencies: \$313,500 of General Fund and \$41,900 in federal funds to the Division of Child and Family Services in the Department of Human Services; and \$138,900 of General Fund to the Courts.
