Provisions of this bill will increase revenue by \$9,500 per year to the General Fund Restricted - Pawnbroker and Secondhand Merchandise Operations Account.

**Individual, Business and/or Local Impact**

Pawn and secondhand businesses that previously were exempted from participating in the state register will be required to participate and pay an annual fee of \$250.
