Those budget actions are presumed in Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environmental Quality Base Budget (S.B. 8, 2011 General Session). Enactment of this bill will reallocate approximately \$1,250,000 in administrative costs between the Department of Environmental Quality and the new Department of Natural Resources and Environment beginning in FY 2013.
