SHORT TITLE: Firearms Modifications

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill is estimated to reduce the number of Utah's concealed weapons permits issued per year by 25%, which will reduce the workload for the Department of Public Safety by \$30,000 in dedicated credits and result in revenue reduction of \$140,000 in dedicated credits per year.
