STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will increase caseloads processed by the Courts. The Courts will require \$53,400 of ongoing General Fund beginning in FY 2012 to meet the bill requirements.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill likely will increase offenders housed in county jails at a total cost of \$9,800 across the state.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill will prohibit businesses from advertising and selling products containing cannabinoids and related paraphernalia to persons under nineteen years of age.
