STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

It is estimated that enactment of this bill will reduce state revenues by \$178,000 in FY 2012 and \$153,800 in FY 2013. It is estimated that in future years there will be a net revenue increase.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))
