SHORT TITLE: Radiologic Technologist and Radiology Practical Technician Licensing Act

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this legislation will result in revenue of \$8,700 in FY 2012, and \$6,800 in odd-numbered years thereafter. Commerce Department expenses associated with the new licensure are estimated at \$6,900 in FY 2012 and \$4,200 annually thereafter. Commerce Service Fund revenue and expenditures affect the annual transfer to the General Fund. As such, this bill will result in transfers to the General Fund of \$1,800 in FY 2012 and \$2,600 in FY 2013 and every odd numbered year thereafter. Transfers to the General Fund will decrease by \$4,200 in even numbered years beyond FY 2013.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

An estimated 125 Radiologist Assistants will pay the license application fee of \$70 in FY 2012. In FY 2013, those same licensees will pay the \$47 renewal fee and 13 new assistants will pay the \$70 application fee.
