H.B. 287 1st Sub. (Buff)

Short Title: Restructuring of the Department of Community and Culture

Sponsor: Harper, W. 2011 General Session, State of Utah

## State Government (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill would cost the Lieutenant Governor's Office \$200,000 to establish a multicultural commission. Establishment of the commission facilitates \$725,500 in budget reductions taken in the Business, Economic Development, and Labor Base Budget (H.B. 5, 2011 General Session).

The bill would save GOED \$104,400 in Private Activity Bond Dedicated Credits currently used for administration in Housing and Community Development. It would cost Housing and Community Development that same \$104,400 from the General Fund. A subsequent General Fund reallocation from GOED to HCD could make the reorganization directed by the bill revenue neutral.
