Beginning in FY 2014, this Legislation will cost the Department of Workforce Services \$26,600 ongoing from the General Fund for 1.25 FTEs and the Department of Health \$361,000 ongoing from the General Fund to pay for Medicaid and CHIP services. Beginning in FY 2014 the State will receive \$1,467,700 federal matching funds for the \$387,600 spent from the General Fund.
