Short Title: Child Protection Registry Amendments

State of Utah

State Government (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill will result in the loss of \$21,700 to the Commerce Service Fund. Revenue to and expenditures from the Commerce Service Fund affect the annual transfer to the General Fund.
