LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill will reduce local Justice Court filings for Class B misdemeanors thereby reducing costs and related revenues associated with those filings. The impact on local county jails is unknown at this time. However, any increase or decrease will affect county jails by \$65 per day per inmate.
