DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Certain trailer owners may experience a registration fee increase of \$14 per year, for a total ongoing cost of \$27,000. Others would pay a \$40 one-time fee for a cumulative cost of \$8,000. Those who pay the \$40 one-time fee would be exempt from future registration fees, resulting in a cumulative ongoing savings of \$28,000 per year.
