## STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill appropriates \$400,000 ongoing Education Fund to the State Office of Education and \$85,000 ongoing Education Fund to the State Board of Regents for implementation of an educational program on the use of information technology.
