STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill likely will not materially impact the state budget.

LOCAL GOVERNMENTS (UCA 36-12-13(2)(c))

Enactment of this bill could reduce property tax revenue by \$20,641,000 to five water conservancy districts.

DIRECT EXPENDITURES BY UTAH RESIDENTS AND BUSINESSES (UCA 36-12-13(2)(d))

Enactment of this bill could reduce property tax revenue paid by residents and businesses by \$20,641,000. This decrease will likely be offset by increased water rates on residents and businesses using water conservancy district services.
