SHORT TITLE: Health Care Associated Infections - As Amended

SPONSOR: Draxler, J. 2012 GENERAL SESSION

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enacting this legislation will cost the Department of Health an estimated \$131,600 ongoing from the General Fund and \$6,900 from federal funds beginning in FY 2013. Costs are for 1.3 full-time equivalent employees to validate and compile health care associated infections information from hospitals and ambulatory surgical facilities.
