SHORT TITLE: Certified Court Reporting Licensing Act Amendments

STATE GOVERNMENT (UCA 36-12-13(2)(b))

Enactment of this bill would increase revenue to the Commerce Service Fund by \$2,300 beginning in FY2013. Costs to the Commerce Department for implementation of the provisions of the bill would be \$2,300 one-time from the Commerce Service Fund. Spending from the Commerce Service Fund affects annual transfers to the General Fund.
